

Uppsala Forum Visiting Fellowship Program Call for Applications

To enhance academic contacts and international presence in the faculties within Uppsala Forum on Democracy, Peace and Justice, **the Uppsala Forum Visiting Fellowship Program** provides an opportunity for scholars within the Uppsala Forum departments to invite scholars and practitioners to spend time (usually between two to six weeks) at one of the Uppsala Forum departments. Uppsala Forum strives towards geographical diversity and gender equality amongst its applicants.

During the stay, the visiting fellow is expected to work in a multi-disciplinary field or with a cross-disciplinary potential which is relevant for a broader group of academic colleagues. The visit can also be aimed at establishing long-term collaboration between researchers or research groups within Uppsala Forum and the visiting fellow's institution. While ample time is given for research, the visitor is also expected to partake in relevant seminar activities and if possible give supervision to PhD students in her/his own field of expertise.

The fellowship funding covers travel and lodging costs. The host department is to provide an office or the equivalent for the total length of the stay.

Visits are normally expected to take place within one year from the date of the application deadline. **The deadline for applications is March 31 for the spring semester and October 31 for the fall semester.** Applications are made on behalf of the host department and must be signed by the Head of Department.
